

Homewatch Briefing for Wilmslow and surrounding areas

Dear Coordinators,

Here is the briefing for September 09:

BURGLARY:

On 11.9.09 offenders unknown entered an uninhabited property in the Wadebrook Grove area of Wilmslow , connected the gas supply, possibly used the cooker and then made off from the scene.

During the day of the 7.9.09 offenders forced ground floor patio doors on a house in the Moor Lane area of Wilmslow. Once inside the property they then made an untidy search and left with various personal possessions .

A burglary was reported to police on 10,9,09 in the Alma Lane area of Wilmslow.

Offenders attempted to gain entry to a house in the Knutsford Road area of Wilmslow but were unsuccessful.

Whilst occupants were asleep in a house in the Carrwood Road area of Wilmslow, offenders entered the property by removing the front door off its hinges. They then remove car keys from a handbag in the hall and then they steal a BMW from the driveway.

Another incident occurred on 17.9.09 in the Marlowe Drive area of Wilmslow. Offenders gained entry to a house by reaching through the cat flap and opening the door with a key left in the lock. A TV and car keys were taken and they drove off in a vehicle which was parked outside the address

Owners arrived home to a house in the Moss Road area of Alderley Edge to be confronted by a male coming down the stairs. The male made his exit through the rear of the property and made his escape

A burglary was reported on 19.9.09 at a house in the Knutsford Road area of Wilmslow. Items were taken from the bedroom in a pillow case and then disguised in a John Lewis carrier bag..

Power tools were stolen from inside a house under renovation in the Manchester Road area of Wilmslow.

Keys were stolen from a window sill at a house in the Holmeswood Close area of Wilmslow and were used to steal a Range Rover from the driveway

A burglary was reported in the Appleton Walk area of Wilmslow on 25.9.09

A laptop and charger were stolen from a house in the Cherington Close area of Handforth

CAR CRIME:

On 7.9.09 a quantity of power tools were stolen from a vehicle parked in the Trafford Road area of Alderley Edge.

Secured bicycles were removed from the rear of a motor home parked in the Nursery Lane area of Wilmslow

During daylight hours offenders approached a secure and unattended vehicle parked in the Priory Road area of Wilmslow and gained entry by barrelling the drivers door lock. A handbag was removed from the front footwell.

A van which had been left insecure and had the keys in the ignition was stolen from the Knutsford Road area of Alderley Edge.

Number plates were stolen from a vehicle in the Hallwood Road area of Wilmslow

A sat nav was taken from a vehicle whilst parked in The Parade area of Alderley Edge.

Offenders smashed the rear offside window on a vehicle parked in a car park in the Styal Road area of Wilmslow and steal a handbag from below the drivers seat.. It is possible the offender was driving a Black Renault Clio.

Number plates were stolen from a vehicle in the London Road area of Alderley Edge

Criminal damage was done to a vehicle parked in a communal car park on 21.9.09 in the Tilston Walk area of Wilmslow

Tools were stolen from the rear of a van parked in the Church Lane area of Alderley Edge on 21.9.09

A theft from vehicle was reported in the Altrincham Road area of Styal on 23.9.09

OTHER:

On 5.9.09 fencing was damaged at a property in the Overhill Road area of Wilmslow.

A hedge trimmer that had been left unattended on the driveway of a house in the Carrwood Road area of Wilmslow was stolen by an unknown thief

A fence panel was stolen from a house in the Redbrook Grove area of Wilmslow on 10.9.09

On 13.9.09 offenders took a lump of rock from a garden in the Blackden Walk area of Wilmslow and then threw it through the kitchen window causing damage.

Youths gathered outside a house in the Gorsey Road area of Wilmslow and proceeded to throw eggs at the window frames causing staining
