Bicycle Crime

A bicycle is stolen every 71 seconds somewhere in the country, most bicycle crime is opportunistic and therefore preventable.

By following some straightforward advice and working in partnership, we can ensure that this type of crime keeps falling.

- Park your bicycle in a safe, well lit place when leaving it unattended.
- Use a garage or shed for storage if you have one at home.
- Always lock the building where your bicycle is stored.
- Use a good quality bicycle lock when leaving your bicycle unattended.
- Property mark your bicycle frame using an ultraviolet pen or other form
 of property marking, to enable it to be returned to you should it be stolen
 and recovered.
- Keep a note of the make, model and serial number and if possible a photograph in case you need to pass the details onto the police.

Reducing bicycle theft is one of the many ways we can all work together to help to reduce crime and disorder within Cheshire.
